

ADOPTING NEW PROJECTS

1. Any YLC member may submit an idea in writing for a new project to the president or an appropriate person appointed by the president (usually VP Projects). The proposal must be submitted on the Project Proposal Form.
2. The president will then bring the proposal to the Executive Committee for consideration. The Executive Committee may request a presentation by the member proposing the project. The Executive Committee will discuss the idea and vote to move the idea forward to the Board for approval, deny the request, or return the proposal to the YLC member for revisions.
3. Once approved by the Executive Committee, the project proposal goes to the Board for consideration of adoption, contingent upon the approval of the requested budget by the Finance Committee.
4. Once the project proposal is approved by the Board of Directors, the member proposing the project should present his or her budget request to the Finance Committee.
5. After approval of the budget request by the Finance Committee, the project as adopted by the Board is considered a new project of the Young Leadership Council, and the new Project Leader must submit an article announcing the new project for inclusion in YLC communications.
