NEW ORLEANS (January 15, 2013) – The YLC invites the New Orleans community to nominate leaders and innovators to be honored as part of its annual Role Model Gala. The Twenty-Seventh Annual YLC Role Model Gala will take place on Saturday, August 10, 2013.

Each year the YLC selects 25 individuals who have distinguished themselves by actively exhibiting the following characteristics:

- Providing effective and vigorous leadership,
- Working to unite our community in collaborative efforts for its future prosperity,

The public is invited to submit nominations through Friday, February 15, 2013. Candidates must live in the New Orleans metro area (Northshore to River Parishes) and cannot currently hold public office. The YLC honors candidates only once in their lifetimes.
