



## BEQUEST DONATION TO YLC

### UNRESTRICTED BEQUESTS

An unrestricted bequest is one for the general use of the organization at the discretion of the Executive Director and the Board of Directors. An example of such a bequest is: "I give and bequeath to The Young Leadership Council (also known as YLC), or its successor, New Orleans, Louisiana [the sum of \$ \_\_\_\_] [\_\_\_\_ percent of my residuary estate] [the following property] for the general support of the organization."

### RESTRICTED BEQUESTS

Donors may restrict the use of their bequests. A restricted bequest might read as follows: "I give and bequeath to The Young Leadership Council (YLC), or its successor, New Orleans, Louisiana [the sum of \$ \_\_\_\_] [\_\_\_\_ percent of my residuary estate] [the following property] to be used for (state purpose, e.g., 'the Leadership Development Series, or its successor'). If, in the opinion of the Executive Director and the Board of Directors, all or part of this bequest cannot be usefully applied to this purpose due to changed circumstances, they may use the bequest for any purpose that in their opinion will most nearly accomplish my wishes and purposes."
